RE: Twilight Tour at the Campbell House Museum on Halloween Night

Campbell House is excited to announce its first annual Halloween Night Twilight Tour!

This is a rare chance to see the home opened up at night and to hear the tragic story and struggles the Campbell family faced during their 84 years of living in the only house remaining on the once-exclusive Lucas Place.

The evening tour through the 10,500 square foot antebellum mansion will explore the tragic deaths of 10 of the Campbell's 13 children, the mental illness that would consume one of their 3 surviving sons, and the less-than-glamorous conditions that people of all classes were forced to endure in 19th century St. Louis.

Since opening in 1943, the Campbell House Museum has served the greater St. Louis area as one of the nation's premier historic property museum. The house, built in 1851, preserves not only the family home of Robert Campbell – a prominent figure in the history of St. Louis and of the American West – but also the family's collection of original furniture, fixtures, paintings, objects and thousands of pages of family documents. Included in these documents is a unique album of 60 photographs of the interior of the house taken around 1885. In 2000, the Museum began a meticulous restoration project that returned the building to its opulent 1880s appearance, when the house was one of the centers of St. Louis society.

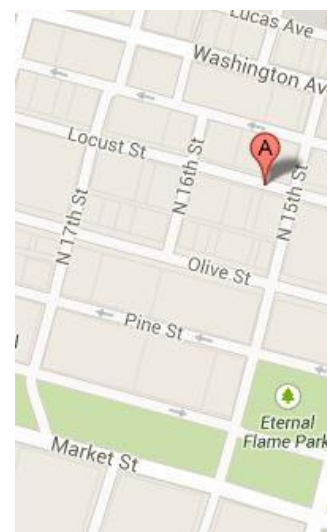
