The Museum is dedicated to continually reinterpreting its collection for exploring issues such as; the development of the West, the growth of urban economies, emigration, historic preservation, principles of Victorian interior design, and the urban issues that continue to shape our region today.”

What are the benefits of my membership?

Campbell House members are entitled to many benefits depending on their level of membership. The basic goodies that all members receive are:

- **Free museum admission and guided tours for two.**

- **Free or discounted admission to public events.**

- **A 10% discount in the Museum Store.**

- **Access to the Missouri History Museum's *Time Travelers* reciprocal membership network, through which members receive exclusive benefits and privileges at museums and historic sites nationwide.**

How does my contribution support the Campbell House?

As a small 501(c)3 nonprofit foundation, the Campbell House Foundation receives no government funding of any kind. Every single aspect of our operations is funded by the generous contributions of community-minded individuals like you. Membership dues and gifts help support our mission of historic preservation and community outreach, fund educational programs and curriculum, and help us keep the lights on so that CHM can continue to operate as one of America's premier historic property museums.

Are my contributions tax-deductible?

Yes, your contribution to the Campbell House Foundation is tax-deductible. However, federal law requires that you deduct the “fair market value” of any benefits you receive from the Museum in return for membership dues. One-time operating donations are fully deductible and the thank-you letter you receive for both types of contributions serves as your receipt. **Always consult your tax professional regarding tax implications of your gift.**
