This event is completely FREE to the public, but limited to the 21 and over crowd. More information can be found online on:

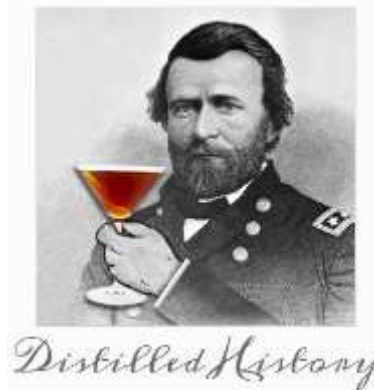

*Since opening in 1943, the Campbell House Museum has served the greater St. Louis area as one of the nation's premier historic property museums. The house, built in 1851, preserves not only the family home of Robert Campbell—a prominent figure in the history of St. Louis and of the American West—but also the family's collection of original furniture, fixtures, paintings, objects and thousands of pages of family documents. In 2000, the Museum began a meticulous restoration project that returned the building to its opulent 1880s appearance, when the house was one of the centers of St. Louis society.*
